This document explains how the Quiz Worx show, 'Family of God', links to and supports the approved curricula for teaching SRE in NSW and RI in QLD.

About the Show

The 'Family of God' show looks at the incredible news of the Bible that anyone, everyone, no matter who they are, no matter what they have done, can be part of God's family through accepting and trusting in God's Son - Jesus.

This is incredible news! This means that people can have the God of the universe, the biggest, most powerful and most loving person of all as their loving heavenly Father. What a privilege.

The show highlights this immensely good news, and shares with kids that this message is for them. The show features all the energy of a Quiz Worx show, using music, puppets, acting, and a re-telling of the story of Zacchaeus from Luke 19:1-9 to unpack this momentous news.

CEP Connect

The Quiz Worx 2019 school show Family of God reinforces Biblical teachings and what Christians believe about who the God of the Bible is. The show links into the CEP Connect 2019 C1 curriculum for teaching SRE (NSW) and RI (QLD) at Lessons 6 & 8 & 10 as well as the Easter Assembly lesson as it explains that Jesus died on the cross to pay for people's sin and that people can now be in God's family by accepting and trusting Jesus.

GodSpace

The Quiz Worx show, *Family of God* reinforces Biblical teachings and what Christians believe about who the God of the Bible is. The show links into the *GodSpace Green 2019* curriculum for teaching SRE (NSW) and RI (QLD) at several points:

Unit 2: Image of a loving God

The aim of this unit is to explore the idea of 'shepherd' as an image of a loving God who gives guidance, care and protection, with Jesus as the Good Shepherd who gave his life for us, and rose again to bring us back to God. Our show explains that anyone, everyone can have this loving God as their own loving, heavenly Father by accepting and trusting God's Son Jesus. Having God as your heavenly Father means people have someone they can always talk to and he will listen. It also means having someone who loves and cares for them no matter what. Jesus made this possible by dying on the cross and coming back to life again to pay for all the things people have done which stopped them from being in God's Family.

Unit 4: Importance of Jesus to His followers

This unit aims to show how important Jesus was to his followers and to impress upon the children that with God's help we can all do amazing things for God. Our show uses the story of Zacchaeus from Luke 19 to show that Jesus changes people and enables people to become his followers and be in God's family.

Extra unit: Prayer at any time

Our show explains that if someone has God as their loving, heavenly Father, it would mean always having someone to talk to and having someone who will listen, no matter what.
