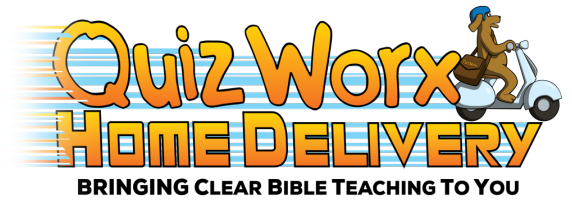


The Greatest Swap in History

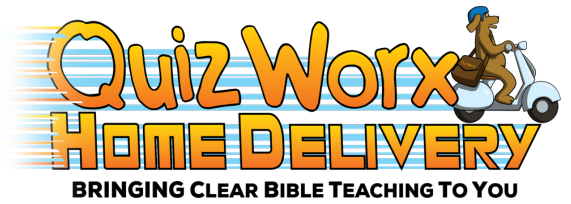
Thank God that Jesus didn't stay dead but swapped his death for life!

How to use 'Digging Deeper' for the 'The Greatest Swap in History' videos.

To help you think more about the greatest swap in history, we have provided three devotions for our Good Friday video & three devotions for our Easter Sunday video.

We encourage you to read these passages with those in your household at a time that suits and use the questions to guide you as you talk about and reflect on Jesus this Easter.

Devotion 1 – Read Luke 24: 1-12

In this passage we read about the first people to discover that Jesus swapped his death for life...

1. Why were the women going to the tomb? What surprise did they get when they arrived?
2. What did the men in shining white clothes tell the women?
3. Why is it so important that Jesus didn't stay dead, but swapped his death for life?

Pray

Thank God for his perfect plan in sending Jesus to die on the cross for all the wrong things that we do, and then swap his death for life.

Ask God to help you to keep trusting Jesus.

Devotion 2 – Read Luke 24: 13-35

After Jesus died on the cross, his followers were devastated. They had thought Jesus was God's promised Saviour and King. Their hopes were dashed...

1. Why were Jesus' disciples "sad and gloomy"?
2. What did Jesus explain to them? How did they respond when they realised that Jesus had swapped his death for life?
3. How did you respond when you first heard that Jesus had swapped his death for life?

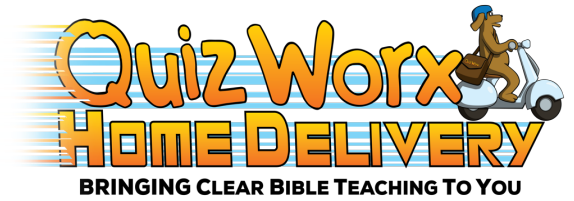
Pray

Devotion 3 – Read Luke 24:36-49

After Jesus was arrested, put on trial, sentenced to death, then killed on the cross, his followers locked themselves away in a room...

1. Why were Jesus' disciples locked in a room?
2. How did they respond when Jesus appeared in the room with them? How did Jesus help them to understand what had happened?
3. What did Jesus tell his disciples to do? Who will help them?

Pray

Thank God that it has always been his plan for Jesus to die and rise again. Thank him that we can read all about his wonderful plan in the Bible.

Ask God to help you tell others about the greatest swap in history, just as Jesus commanded his followers in Luke 24:47-49. Thank God that he has given us his Holy Spirit to help us.
